#### FORM F-1

#### Macro Economic Framework Statement

#### A. Overview of the State Economy and GSDP Growth Rate:

The GSDP at current market prices for the year 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21 was estimated at ₹29508.30 crore, ₹33480.64 crore, ₹36571.81 crore and ₹34802.52 crore respectively, registering an annual percentage growth of 13.46 percent, 9.23 percent and -4.84 percent respectively. At constant (2011-12) prices, the GSDP of the state during the same period was estimated at ₹22564.33 crore, ₹24681.96 crore, ₹26695.23 crore and ₹24468.80 crore with corresponding annual growth of 9.38 percent, 8.16 percent and -8.34 percent.

The share of **Primary Sector** (Agriculture, Livestock, Forestry, Fishery and Mining & Quarrying) at current market prices accounted for 23.56 percent, 21.70 percent, 20.57 percent and 22.24 percent during the year 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21 respectively. During the same period, its share of GSDP at constant (2011-12) prices were 21.58 percent, 20.14 percent, 19.06 percent and 20.43 percent respectively.

The **Secondary Sector** contributed 18.55 percent in 2017-18, 19.65 percent in 2018-19, 20.95 percent in 2019-20 and 20.25 percent in 2020-21 to the GSDP at current market prices. At constant (2011-12) prices, its contribution were 18.22 percent, 19.12 percent, 20.25 percent and 19.55 percent during the same period.

The **Service/Tertiary Sector** being the major contributor towards the economy of the state contributed 57.90 percent in 2017-18, 58.65 percent in 2018-19, 58.48 percent in 2019-20 and 57.51 percent in 2020-21 to the GSDP at current market prices. At constant (2011-12) market prices, its contribution during the same period were 60.20 percent, 60.74 percent, 60.69 percent and 60.02 percent respectively.

The **Per Capita GSDP** at current market prices stood at ₹86,459/-, ₹96,016/-, ₹1,02,672/- and ₹95,664/- during 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21 respectively, showing an annual increase of 11.05 percent, 6.93 percent and -6.83 percent. The estimates of per capita GSDP at constant (2011-12) prices were ₹66,113/-, ₹70,783, ₹74,945/- and ₹67,259/- with the corresponding annual growth of 7.06 percent, 5.88 percent and -10.26 percent during the same period respectively.

Along with the rest of the country, COVID-19 induced lockdown has adversely impacted all the economic activities in the state as well, especially in the unorganized sector. Agriculture and allied activities were the least affected as compared to other activities of the economy. It may be noted that unlike many other states, Meghalaya did not experience mass migration of agricultural labourers as the workforce consists mainly of locals.

There was large scale unemployment in activities like manufacturing, transport, hospitality businesses, entertainment, and trading activities; in short, in the whole of the services sector of the State.

Given the abrupt onset and nature of the pandemic in the country and the State, the following assumptions were made in estimating the State's GSDP:

With regards to the Primary sector, the impact on mining was the worst while that of Agriculture and Allied activities remain relatively unaffected; the growth in GSDP from this sector is estimated at about 2.12% during 2020-21 as compared to a growth of 4.24% in 2019-20.

Manufacturing and Construction activities are estimated to effect a negative growth of -11.94% and -11.91% respectively thereby affecting a negative growth of -8.70% in the Secondary Sector, i.e. a decrease from ₹ 7222.57 crore in 2019-20 to ₹ 6593.92 crore in 2020-21.

Services/Tertiary sector is estimated to register a negative growth of -7.10%, i.e a fall from ₹ 20155.73 crore in 2019-20 to ₹ 18724.06 crore in 2020-21.

Given the above scenario, the GSDP is estimated to reduce by -4.84% in 2020-21.

#### **Overview of the State Government Finances:**

The revenue deficit of ₹151.60 crore during 2019-20 (Actual) is lower than the revenue deficit of ₹537.32 crore during 2018-19 (Actual) as the State was able to contain the revenue expenditure even as the revenue receipt was lower than that of 2018-19. The State is expected to better its performance during 2020-21 (RE) and is estimated to turn the deficit into a surplus of ₹925.01 crore as the revenue receipt is estimated to be higher than revenue expenditure.

The lower revenue deficit during 2019-20 (Actual) as compared to 2018-19 (Actual) improved the fiscal deficit to ₹1103.77 crore against ₹2026.07 crore deficit the previous year. The Fiscal Deficit during 2020-21 (RE) is estimated to increase to ₹1532.62 crore as the State intends to increase its capital outlay.

The Primary Deficit was ₹345.26 crore during 2019-20 (Actual) and is estimated to increase to ₹689.45 crore during 2020-21 (RE).

Ways and Means Advances: The State has not availed any WMA from RBI during 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-12 (April 2020– February 2021).

- B. The fiscal performance against major parameters in the Actual 2019-20, Revised Estimates of 2020-21, Budget Estimates of 2021-22 and the rolling targets for the next three financial years is indicated in the above Table.
- C. The State had a revenue deficit of ₹151.60 crore during 2019-20 on account of comparatively higher revenue expenditure. The State is estimated to have a revenue surplus during 2020-21 (RE) and 2021-22 (BE) and in the projections for the next three years 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024.25.
- D. The fiscal deficit during 2019-20 is 3.02 percent of GSDP which is within the statutory limit of 4.1% of GSDP as fixed by the FRBM (Amendment) Act, 2020 as a special dispensation during the fiscal year 2019-20 only allowed by Government of India in view of lower devolution of Central Taxes to the State. For 2020-21 (RE), the fiscal deficit is estimated at 4.40 percent of GSDP. However, this is within the limit of 5 percent of GSDP fixed by the FRBM (Amendment) Ordinance, 2021 in view of additional borrowing of 2 percent of GSDP provided by Government of India subject to implementation of specific State Level Reforms and amendment of FRBM Act to strengthen the resources in the hands of the State Governments to fight the COVID-19 pandemic and maintain the standards of service delivery to the public. The fiscal deficit during 2021-22 (BE) is estimated at 4.07 percent of GSDP. The deficit is estimated at 4.17 percent of GSDP in 2022-23 and is estimated to gradually reduce to 3.90 percent and 3.45 percent of GSDP by 2023-24 and 2024-25, respectively.
- E. The total liabilities as a percentage of GSDP is 31.54 percent during 2019-20 (Actual). The same is estimated at 37.39 percent of GSDP during 2020-21 as the GSDP of the State during the year is estimated to fall from the level of 2019-2020 as a result of the impact of COVID-19 pandemic and lockdown. The total liabilities are estimated at 36.58 percent of GSDP during 2021-22 (BE). In the next three years 2022-23, 2023.24 and 2024-25 the liabilities are estimated at 36.30 percent, 36.71 percent and 36.69 percent respectively.

Assumptions made in connection with the above estimates on the Medium Term Fiscal Policy:

#### 1. Receipts:

(a) Revenue Receipts: The State's Own Tax Revenue is ₹1891.25 crore in 2019-20 (Actual), this is estimated increase to ₹2376.98 crore during 2020-21 (RE) and ₹2579.23 crore during 2021-22 (BE). In the next three years, 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25 the State's Own Tax Revenue is projected estimated at ₹3019.92 crore, ₹3535.91 crore and ₹4140.06 crore respectively. An annual growth rate of 17 percent has been assumed in projecting the State's Own Tax.

The State's Own Non-Tax Revenue is ₹530.11 crore in 2019-20 (Actual), this is estimated increase to ₹690.29 crore during 2020-21 (RE) and ₹694.04 crore during 2021-22 (BE). In the next three years, 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25, the State's Own Non-Tax Revenue is estimated at ₹783.38 crore, ₹884.22 crore and ₹998.04 crore respectively. An annual growth rate of 13 percent has been assumed in projecting the State's Own Non-Tax Revenue.

The State's Share of Central Taxes is ₹4211.78 crore in 2019-20. It was estimated at ₹5998.98 crore during 2020-21 (RE) and ₹5104.88 crore during 2021-22 (BE). As per the recommendations of the Fifteenth Finance Commission, the State's share of Central Taxes is calculated at ₹5619 crore, ₹6323 crore and ₹7183 crore during 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25 respectively.

Other Central transfers such as grants for under Finance Commission, Central Sector and Centrally Sponsored Schemes, NEC, NLCPR and EAPs, etc. is ₹2780.38 crore in 2019-20 (Actual). This is estimated at ₹6286.34 crore in 2020-21 (RE) and ₹6853.65 crore in 2021-22 (BE). In the next three years, 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25, Central transfers are estimated at ₹7539.02 crore, ₹8292.92 crore and ₹9122.21 crore respectively. An annual growth rate of 10 percent has been assumed in projecting the Central transfers.

(b) Capital Receipts: the total capital receipt is ₹1527.34 crore in 2019-20. This is estimated at ₹1846.97 crore in 2020-21 (RE) and ₹1997.71 crore 2021-22 (BE). The capital receipt is projected at ₹2301.56 crore, ₹2651.88 crore and ₹3055.79 crore during the next three years, 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25. Recovery of Loans & Advances is projected at an annual growth rate of 6 percent and Borrowings at 15 percent.

#### 2. Expenditure:

- (a) Revenue Expenditure: The Revenue Expenditure is ₹9565.12 crore in 2019-20 (Actual). The expenditure is estimated at ₹14427.58 crore during 2020-21 (RE) and ₹13956.47 crore during 2021-22 (BE). The Revenue Expenditure is projected at ₹ 15466.39 crore, ₹17139.67 crore and ₹18993.98 crore during the next three years 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25 respectively. The revenue expenditure has been projected at an annual growth rate of 11percent.
- (b) Capital Expenditure: The total capital expenditure is ₹1402.20 crore in 2019-20 (Actual). The expenditure is estimated to increase to ₹2829.55 crore in 2020-21 (RE) and ₹3366.88 crore during 2021-22 (BE). The same is projected at ₹3871.57 crore, ₹4284.14 crore and ₹5011.61 crore during 2022-23, 2023-24 and ₹2024-25 crore respectively. Capital outlay is projected at an annual growth rate of 14 percent and loans & advances at 10 percent.

#### 3. Outstanding liabilities:

The Outstanding liabilities were 31.54 percent of GSDP during 2019-20 (Actual). The liabilities are estimated at 37.39 percent during 2020-21 (RE) and 36.58 percent during 2021-22 (BE). The same are projected at 36.30 percent, 36.71 percent and 36.69 percent of GSDP during 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25 respectively.

#### FORM F-3

#### **Fiscal Policy Strategy Statement**

A. Fiscal Policy Overview: The fiscal policy during 2020-21has been greatly influenced by the impact of COVID-19 pandemic and lockdown which adversely affected the economy of the country and the State with resultant negative impact on the revenue receipts of the State, both on the State's Own Tax and Non-Tax Revenue and Share of Central Taxes.

To augment its resources due to the fall in revenue receipts, the State adopted a number of revenue augmenting measures such as the Meghalaya Settlement of Arrear, etc. Act, 2020 offering tax remission to defaulters for waiver of 30% of total arrear payable, introduction of Retailer's Lifting Fee of 25% on Retail Prices of all types of liquor, amendment of MMMCR;2016, issuing of transport challans to lease holders after payment of Royalty, Reclamation fee, Cess, DMF, etc., steps to stop fake challans and multiple use of single challans, re-registration of goods carrying vehicles proportionate to pay-load capacity, revision of rates of fancy registration numbers; rate of Motor Vehicle Tax and Composite Tax on Tourist Vehicles, etc.

The State Government also took a number of measures to control expenditure such as continuation of temporary withdrawal of DFP Rules, 2006 effected in 2019-20, imposition of economy measures, deferment of salary, restriction of certain establishment expenditure to 70% percent of budget estimates, etc.

However, fall in receipts, coupled with additional expenditure to control the spread of the pandemic and other social and health related expenditure in view of COVID-19, has put the finances of the State under a lot of stress resulting in a fiscal deficit of ₹1679 crore, i.e. about 4.76 percent of GSDP by the third quarter of the fiscal year.

Recognising that the unprecedented COVID-19 pandemic has had a serious negative impact on the resources of both the Central and State Governments, and that the State Governments would require additional resources to fight the pandemic and maintain the standards of service delivery to the public, and to strengthen the resources in the hands of the State

Governments, the Central Government provided the States additional borrowing limit of up to 2 percent of GSDP, subject to implementation of specific State Level Reforms and amendment of FRBM Act raising the Fiscal Deficit limit to 5 percent of GSDP for the fiscal year 2020-21.

- B. Fiscal Policy for the ensuing financial year: The fiscal policy for 2021-22 will be guided by the objectives of the FRBM Act, that is to: (a) generate revenue surplus and reduce fiscal deficit and build up adequate surplus for discharging the liabilities and for developmental expenditures; (b) pursue policies to raise non tax revenue with due emphasis on cost recovery and equity; (c) prioritize capital expenditure and to pursue an expenditure policy that would provide impetus for economic growth with social equity and improvement in poverty reduction and human welfare.
  - 1. Tax Policy and Non Tax Policy: The State Government will continue with its regular review or revenue collection of major revenue earning Departments to identify and introduce new revenue collection measures.
  - 2. Expenditure Policy: Apart from making adequate provision for meeting committed liabilities such as salaries, pension, interest payment and repayment of loans and advances, the Government will continue to provide adequate resources for expenditure on social and economic infrastructure, along with tourism and industries, which are sectors that have the potential to provide livelihood and employment opportunities.
  - **3. Borrowings:** The debt policy of the Government will be guided by the fiscal targets fixed by the FRBM Act with due regard to financial implications on the future generation and the fiscal deficit targets.
  - **4. Consolidated Sinking Fund:** During 1999-2000 the State Government constituted the "Consolidated Sinking Fund" for redemption and amortization of open market loan. Closing balance in the Fund till the end of December, 2020 is ₹739.90 crore. An amount of ₹66.43 crore is estimated for contribution to the Fund during the ensuing fiscal year, 2021-22 (BE).

- 5. Contingent and other Liabilities: Though at present there is no statutory limit as to the outstanding amount of contingent liabilities, the State is guided by the fiscal targets stipulated by the FRBM Act, 2006, i.e. restricting the issue of guarantees, except on selective basis where the viability of the scheme to be guaranteed is assured and the scheme is beneficial to the State. To service contingent liabilities arising out of the invocation of State Government Guarantees, the Government constituted the 'Guarantee Redemption Fund' in 2014-15 managed by the Reserve Bank of India. Balance in the Fund as at the end of 2019-20 is ₹32.08 crore. An amount of ₹5.60 crore is estimated for contribution during 2020-21 (RE) and ₹11.00 crore during 2021-22 (BE)
- **6.** Levy of User Charges: At present, not much revenue is raised by the State Government from user charges, except for a nominal amount from Government school fees, hospital charges, house water connection in urban areas, etc.
