**BUDGET ESTIMATES FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2021-2022** - Vote on Account for seven months as passed by the Legislative Assembly - Communicated.

# ORDER No.106, Finance [Budget Co-ordination], dated 10<sup>th</sup> March 2021.

The Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly has voted without reduction the advance Demands for Grants for the financial year 2021-2022 as presented to it on the 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2021. The advance Demands for Grants as Voted by the Legislative Assembly are intended to cover the expenditure of the State on existing services for the first seven months of the financial year commencing on the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2021. The Budget Estimates of Expenditure for seven months for which "Vote on Account" has been obtained is communicated separately to all Heads of Department and other Estimating Officers. They are requested to ensure that the total expenditure under each grant for the period of first seven months of the financial year does not exceed the "Vote on Account", until the Budget Estimates for the entire financial year 2021-2022 are passed by the Legislative Assembly.

2. A copy of the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 2021 (Act No.10 of 2021) is appended to this order for information.

The following Act of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly received the assent of the Governor on the 9th March 2021 and is hereby published for general information.

### ACT No. 10 of 2021

An Act to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of a part of the financial year which commencing on the 1st day of April 2021.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Seventy-Second Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 2021.

Short Title.

- 2. The State Government may withdraw from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State sums not exceeding Two Lakh Twenty One Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty Six Crore Thiry Five Lakh and Forty Thousand rupees, being moneys required to meet--
- Withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for a part of the financial year commencing on the 1st day of April 2021.
- (a) the grants made in advance by the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly for a part of the financial year commencing on the 1st day of April 2021, as set forth in column (3) of the Schedule; and
- (b) the expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund of the State for the said part of that year, as set forth in column (4) of the Schedule.
- 3. The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund under section 2 shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to that year.
